



Cyprus location

species of flora and fauna

The worldwide famous beaches of Cyprus are famous of their cleanliness and they are a very important to the tourist industry. The management of the beaches brings a great financial benefit in the economy in general. Beyond the great impact to the economy, the entertainment to tourists who visit the island and also the local people, the beaches of Cyprus provide an important habitat for many species of flora and fauna. Species like the sea turtle Careta Careta, the green turtle and the Mediterranean seal are considered endangered species by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN)

The beach experience varies from coast to coast, with unique characteristics for each region, including the color of the sands and waters; the marine life and natural significance; the organized facilities and water sports available, and the popularity - or seclusion - of the shore. One common factor that unites all coasts and beaches is the seal of quality. The island consistently receives awards, accolades and top rankings for its water quality and safety, its eco-initiatives and the general cleanliness of its beaches. Cyprus is the proud recipient of 68 Blue Flag beaches - an eco-label awarded to beaches and marinas across the globe that meet its standards - and is also crowned 'Cleanest Bathing Waters in Europe,' with a consistent 100% score, year after year.
